MEMORANDUM OF THE ASSOCIATION

EXISTING CLAUSE

NAME

The name of the Association shall be "The Association of the Physically Handicapped".

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The name of the Association shall be "The Association of People with Disability".

AMENDED

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REGISTERED OFFICE - JURISDICTION

The Registered Office of the Association shall be at Bangalore at a House No. 100, Lingarajapuram, P.O. 1st Stage Town, Bangalore - 560 001 and its activities shall extend to all parts of Mysore State.

The Registered Office of the Association shall be at 1st Cross Huttich Road, Hennes Road, Lingarajapuram, P.O. St. Thomas Town, Bangalore - 560 001 and its activities shall extend to all parts of Karnataka.

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AIMS AND OBJECTS

Clause 2

To be concerned primarily with those who are orthopaedically handicapped.

Clause 2

To be concerned primarily with those who are disabled.

Clause 2

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Clause 3

To start a training center to rehabilitate the members of the Association by affording them vocational training facilities in spinning, weaving, tailoring, embroidery and other occupations which do not involve heavy manual labor.

Clause 3

To start a training center to rehabilitate disabled members of society by affording them Socio-Economic services.

To undertake measures for the long term economic rehabilitation of the members of the Association by entering the names of suitable candidates with the Employment Ex-

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To undertake measures for long term socio-economic welfare of the disabled by enabling them to become self-reliant and integrate them into the main stream of the

Clause : 5
To arrange visitors of the disabled in the State and to secure the co-operation of the Government and other institutions, both private and public for the satisfaction of their needs.

RULES AND BYE LAWS
MEMBERSHIP CLAUSE:

Clause : 1 (i)
The membership shall be open to all those who are physically handicapped and to all who sympathize with the aims and objects of the Association and those persons who have applied membership in a form to be prescribed and have been admitted as members by the Committee of Management.

Clause : 1(ii)
The membership fee for the physically handicapped persons shall be Rs.5/- per annum and others Rs.10/- per annum. Those who subscribe Rs.250/- and above shall be entitled the membership for life and those who subscribe Rs.1,000/- and above shall be patrons of the Association.

Clause : 2(a)
The day to day affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Managing Committee. The Managing Committee shall consist of nine permanent members and five elected members. The five elected members shall be elected at each Annual General Meeting of the Association.

Clause : 4
To serve as a Resource Centre to secure the co-operation of the Government and other institutions both private and public.

MEMBERSHIP CLAUSE:

Clause : 1(i)
The membership shall be open to persons having completed 18 years of age and to all who sympathize with the aims and objects of the Association. Such of those persons should have applied membership in the form prescribed and have been admitted as members by the Committee of Management.

Clause : 1(ii)
The membership fee for the persons shall be Rs.25/- per annum. Those who subscribe Rs.500/- and above shall be entitled to the membership for life and those who subscribe Rs.1,000/- and above shall be patrons of the Association.

Clause : 2(a)
The day to day affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Managing Committee. The Managing committee shall consist of 7 trustees and 3 members. The five members shall be elected at each Annual General Meeting of the Association.

Clause 201

At each Annual General Meeting of the Association, the members other than permanent members shall retire and they will be eligible for re-election.

Clause 202

In the event of vacancies occurring in the Committee in respect of permanent members, the remaining permanent members of the Committee shall fill the same by appointment of persons who are distinguished social workers. The person or persons so appointed shall ipso facto become trustee or trustees.

Clause 20A

The permanent members of the Committee of Management shall be Trustees of the Association. No person shall be eligible to be a Trustee unless he is a permanent member of the Committee of Management. The President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Secretary and Assistant Secretary shall be elected by the Trustees from among themselves.

Clause 201

At each Annual General Meeting of the Association the elected members shall retire and they will be eligible for re-election.

Clause 202

Vacancies arising in the office of the Elected Members of the Committee shall be filled by the Committee of Management from among the members of the Association and/or from distinguished social workers for the unexpired term.

Clause 20A

Nine Trustees shall be members of the Managing Committee. The Family of the Donor of the land has the option to nominate a family member as a trustee. The tenure of a Trustee shall be 5 years from the date of his/her election. Each year a maximum of 2 (two) trustees shall retire by rotation in order of their seniority. The retiring trustees shall also be eligible for re-election. In the event of vacancies occurring in respect of Trustees, the remaining Trustees shall fill the same by appointment of person who are distinguished social worker or persons of standing in society. The person or persons so appointed shall ipso facto become trustee or trustees.

Clause : 2.B
The Committee of Management shall appoint among themselves an Executive Officer of the Association on such remuneration, designation and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

Clause : 2.L
The funds of the Association shall be operated by any two of the following persons:

1. Honorary President
2. Honorary Secretary
3. Honorary Treasurer

All cheques shall be signed by the Treasurer and President and Secretary.

Special Powers 3rd para:
The Executive Officer to be appointed by the Committee of Management shall be responsible only for the running and maintenance of Training with Subsidisation Centre. He will work on the guidelines provided by the Committee of Management with Powers on this disciplinary action against any member or staff and Trainee.

Meeting of the Committee of Management.

Clause : 4)
The Committee of Management shall meet at least once in two months, usually once every month. The Quorum for the meeting of the Committee of Management shall be 8 or 50% whichever is less. All questions shall be decided by a majority of votes in person and shall be binding on the Association. When there is equality of votes, the President shall have a casting vote.

The Committee of Management shall appoint a Chief Executive of the Association on such remuneration, designation and on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

Clause : 2.L
The Accounts of the Association shall be operated jointly by Honorary Treasurer and any of the following two

2. Honorary Secretary

Clause : 7
Special Powers 2nd para:
The Chief Executive, to be appointed by the Managing Committee shall be responsible for carrying out the activities of the Association as per directions of the Managing Committee.

Clause : 8
Meeting of the Committee of Management and Trustees.

Clause : 4)
The Committee of Management shall meet at least once in two months, normally once every month. The Quorum for the meeting of the Committee of Management shall be 8 or 50% whichever is less. All questions shall be decided by a majority of votes of those present. When there is equality of votes, the President shall have the casting vote.

The Committee of Management shall be the supreme authority to regulate appointments, accept resignation enforce discipline and dismiss any member of the staff staff for misconduct or misbehavior. Likewise the Committee of Management shall be the supreme authority to regulate admission of trainees into the Training Centre and to enforce discipline and removal of any undesirable trainee on grounds of misconduct or misbehavior. Before disciplinary action is taken opportunity shall be afforded to the staff or trainee concerned to offer a satisfactory explanation or defence. In emergency cases the President shall have similar powers of dismissal or removal and shall lay such action notified at the next meeting of the Committee of Management.

Clause 12

Programme of the Annual General Meeting:
The Annual General Body shall have the following powers:

1. To accept the annual report and to approve the audited statement of accounts presented by the Committee of Management
2. To appoint an auditor.
3. To elect five retiring members to the Committee of Management for the ensuing year after the expiry of the existing Committee.

Clause 12

The Trustees shall meet at least once a year and more often if required. The quorum for the Trustees meeting shall be five.

Clause 11

The Committee of Management shall be the supreme authority to regulate appointments, accept resignation enforce discipline including dismissing any member for acts of misconduct.

Clause 12

Programme of the Annual General Meeting:
The following ordinary business shall be transacted at the Annual General Body Meeting:

1. To receive, consider and adopt the audited statement of annual accounts and the annual report of the Committee of Management.
2. To elect members to the Committee of Management.
3. To appoint and fix the remuneration of Auditor.
4. To consider and transact any other business other than the above as special business provided appropriate notice has been served to the members
